Including anti-slavery and human trafficking clauses in our contracts with suppliers.

Training to our employees to ensure they understand the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking and are aware of the signs to look out for.

Reporting and Accountability

We encourage all employees, suppliers, and stakeholders to report any concerns related to modern slavery or human trafficking. Reports can be made through our confidential reporting mechanisms, and we are committed to investigating all reports thoroughly and taking appropriate action.

We are committed to continuously improving our policies and practices to combat modern slavery and human trafficking. We will regularly review and update this statement to reflect any changes in legislation or best practices.
